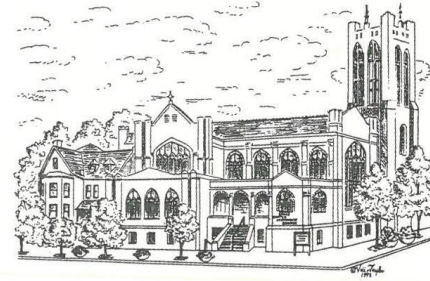
CHOIRS BEGIN ON SEPTEMBER 5
