Breakthrough Talk by Cindy Lawyer [4/8/18]

The cards you are receiving are a result of a Breakthrough Prayer Initiative that a group of Grace Church members attended last year. Does everyone have one...

Breakthrough – when I looked up the word, it means sudden dramatic, important, advance discovery or development. Science has breakthroughs, there are breakthroughs in medicine, and technology has breakthroughs – sudden dramatic development!

Relationships have breakthroughs and you could even have a breakthrough in your marriage or career... I think you get the idea!

Because the opposite of this is a set-back...If you are not moving forward you are stalled, maybe at an impasse or a dead end. Ultimately you need to BREAK THROUGH in order to move forward!!

In Philippians 4:6-8 it says: Don't worry about anything; instead pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

To get personal with you. I have had 4-5 people from our church congregation voice their concern about the future of Grace Church. It is personal for ALL OF US! It is like an elephant in the room... IT NEEDS TO BE ADDRESSED!

It reminds me of the saying: If you do what you've always done...you'll get what you've always gotten.

We are in danger....we need a lifeline. As Christians, it needs to be an admission to God that we need help....through prayer.

Is that such a novel idea?

In Matthew 18:19-20 God says: "I also tell you this: If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, my father in heaven will do it for you. For where two or three gather together in my name, I am there among them."

Prayer – is a personal relationship with God and comes in many forms, from a long drawn out conversation to a split second plea.

The card you're holding has been long in the making. As a group we met many times hashing over what we thought needed to be said to God:

Keep it short and to the point, but as a breakthrough it must be meaningful, dramatic and important and in OUR circumstances... for the life of our church!!

Looking at the front: "Dreams of the future, become reality through prayer."

What are your dreams for the future of Grace Church?

Notice it says: Pray boldly at 5:16 p.m. daily! – Does it have to be at exactly 5:16?... maybe a little before or after... maybe 5:16 a.m.?

Open the card:

God of Miracles.

We praise your Holy name and thank you for loving us!

Unleash your power within us...

Break through our hearts and minds... so we will be open to your God-sized plans.

Let your light shine through us, so we may be an example of your love to others!

In the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

On the back, we see that same verse, from the book of Mathew 5:16 ... which is when we want to collectively say this prayer as a plea to God to make a change... to breakthrough.

This also happens to be the address of our church — 516 Shinnick St. Coincidence or God-incidence?
