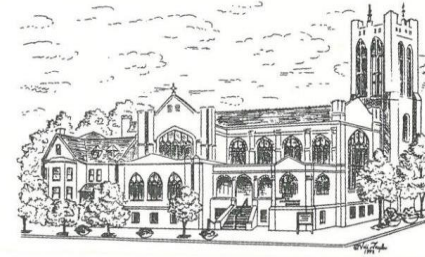
## RACE FOR GRACE — Thanksgiving Day — November 22, 2018
