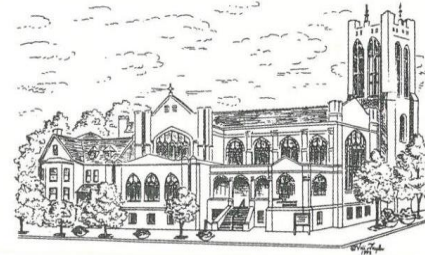
RACE FOR GRACE 2017 — 5K Run / Walk
